# Solo Piping Competition (Grade 1, 2, 3, 4, & 5) and 100 PIPERS AND DRUMMERS

### I. RULES FOR SOLO PIPING COMPETITION

<u>Order of Play:</u> Competitors will play in the order determined by the Games Sponsor. However, the Games Sponsor or judge has the right to adjust any preassigned times in order to eliminate large gaps in the contest due to cancellations or disgualifications.

It is the responsibility of solo piping competitors to arrive on time, to check in with the appropriate Games Official and to check periodically on his or her starting time. Competitors not on hand when called will forfeit entry in that event. Every effort will be made to notify individuals of changes in the times. As they occur, changes will be posted in a central location.

<u>Tuning</u>: Pipers shall be limited to a five minute tuning time for all solo events.

Contest will be organized under the WUSPBA Sanctioning Process

#### II. 100 PIPERS AND DRUMMERS

There is \*no fee\* for participating. This event is for competition soloists <u>or other</u> musicians who are not members of bands performing at the Modesto Games, but who would like to perform as part of the Massed Band during Opening and/or Closing Ceremonies. 1. You must bring your own instrument (bagpipe, side drum, tenor drum, or bass drum); 2. You must be performance-ready with the massed band tunes (Scotland the Brave, No Awa', Green Hills of Tyrol, Amazing Grace); 3. You must assemble with the massed band approximately 15 minutes prior to performance for warm-up, tune-up, and parade formation line-up. Let's make this great!
